

Winter Regue Hand Treatment

Training Guide



Introduction:

As the winter season approaches so does the onset of environmental changes to our skin's condition which can lead to a whole range of uncomfortable issues. In particular the backs of our hands may become very dry and even chapped. Remnants of Summer sun exposure may also cause the hands to look dull and dehydrated with possible pigmentation. The dip in outdoor temperature can strip vital oils from the skin and the onset of turning on the central heating often resulting in moisture loss.

We can advise our clients to wear cozy gloves when they are outdoors, to use washing up gloves when doing the dishes and avoid cleaning with harsh chemicals as well as the daily use of hand cream.

For those who are experiencing winter hands symptoms we can recommend the Eve Taylor® **Winter Rescue Hand Treatment.**

This targeted hand treatment is perfect to offer to clients as a stand alone service, as part of a manicure or as an add-on to the Winter Rescue Facial.

Products needed:

Ultra Soothing Cleanser
Lavender Hydrolat
Exfoliating Mousse
Regenerative Serum
Soothing Masque
Colloidal Activator
Lavender AromaWax Massage Candle
Hand and Nail Rescue Cream (SPF20)

Treatment time:

20 minutes.

Treatment protocol:

- 1. Cleanse the hands with **Ultra Soothing Cleanser** customised with a few drops of **Lavender Hydrolat**. Remove product by enveloping hands with hot mitts or steam towels.
- 2. Exfoliate the back of the hands, tops of fingers and around cuticles with **Exfoliating Mousse**. Remove product thoroughly with hot mitts or steam towels.
- 3. Apply **Regenerative Serum** to the backs of the hands, tops of fingers and gently massage into cuticles.
- 4. Mix two pumps of **Colloidal Activator** with one pump of **Soothing Masque** and 4 drops of **Lavender Hydrolat** in a bowl and stir with masque brush to create a creamy gel consistency

With a masque brush apply to backs of hands, tops of fingers and cuticles. Allow to infuse into the skin for 10 minutes.

Optional: Hands may be placed into liners followed by hot mitts for additional warming, comforting benefits.

While masque is on, carry out optional nail file and cuticle work should your client require it to ensure a neat finish to your treatment.

Alternatively carry out **Skin Profiling Analysis** on your client's skin and complete **Skin Profiling Recommendation Sheet** with product recommendations.

Remove Masque with hot mitts or steam towels

- 5. Carry out hand and arm massage with Lavender AromaWax Massage Candle.
- 6. Apply Hand & Nail Rescue Cream (SPF20) to hands.

Treatment cost to perform:

Ensure you use the Cost Modeler available in the professional area of the website to calculate a costing accurate to the size of products used.

Treatment course:

The Eve Taylor® Winter Rescue Hand Treatment is designed to give immediate improvements to the skin. If homecare is adhered to between treatments then we recommend ongoing treatments at 2-4 week intervals over an 8-12 week period.

Homecare products and retail:

To maintain the results of the **Winter Rescue Hand Treatment** we would recommend: **Regenerative Serum** – applied to the backs of hands and massaged into cuticles as needed.

Hand & Nail Rescue Cream (SPF20) - applied daily.
